HATI means *HEART*: this is expressed at Bali Hati through our humanitarian approach to all activities and an administration that is guided by the highest of ethical and spiritual values.

Bali Hati Foundation is a non-profit, non-political and non-denominational community-owned organization, structured and operated in accordance with Indonesian Law, and registered as non-profit in Bali and in the United States where it operates under the aegis of the National Heritage Foundation.

## *Our Mission*

- ♥ To improve the skills of Bali's people through implementing formal and informal educational opportunities and to provide scholarships for motivated students who could not otherwise afford the costs of education.
- ♥ To improve the level and quality of the island's public health through effective community-based health programs.
- ♥ To raise the community's awareness of various prevailing social, economic and health problems, and to heighten community participation in alleviating these problems.



# Education Program

**THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM** began in 1997 to sponsor students at all levels of schooling. High school and university recipients have to maintain a high grade point average in order to continue their scholarships. A Swedish foundation funds most of our university scholarships. All others are funded by the generosity of individual donors who "adopt" young scholars. *The Bali Hati Foundation has supported more than 1100 students since 1997.*



**THE COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAM** is focused on what is viewed as two essential areas: English and computer skills. The program offers state-certified English and computer courses. The courses are available free of charge to students from low-income families. The decision to provide scholarships is based on the recommendation of the head of the village the student comes from and a home survey. *Up to October 2006, more than 1700 students attended these courses with more than 50% of the students on scholarship.*



**BALI HATI SCHOOL** was started as a kindergarten in 1999 and now offers elementary grades 1 through 6. Plans are in development for a secondary school with fundraising activities to cover capital costs. Potential donors are invited to contact us for more information including opportunities for naming rights.

In July 2006, at its first 6th grade graduation, the school was ranked No. 1 in Ubud and No. 7 in Gianyar Regency, in association with SDN 6 Mas, from approximately 300 elementary schools based on the students' achievement in the government's national graduation examination.

While following the National Curriculum, the school enriches its child-centered, interactive learning program with English and computer classes, class projects, public speaking, cooking, arts and crafts, story telling and field trips. A bilingual program in the elementary school begins in July 2007.

Subsidized tuition and scholarships are available for students who come from low-income families. Students are selected by a



Scholarship Committee following an enrollment test and a home visit.

*At least 50% of students at Bali Hati School are on scholarships.*

A Sister Schools Program was begun in 2004 between Bali Hati School and the Glenaeon Rudolf Steiner School in Australia. Potential sister schools worldwide are invited to contact us for details.



## Health Program

Our **HEALTH PROGRAM** began in response to the tragedy of the October 2002 Kuta bombing with assistance at the site and medical and financial support to over 90 bomb victims.

The **MOBILE HEALTH CLINIC** now operates throughout Bali and provides dental treatment for children as well as gynecological and medical services and health education for villagers. *Over 6000 people have benefited from this program.*



Villagers can come weekly to an **AUDIOLOGIST** at Bali Hati for hearing evaluation and suggested treatment. This free service is provided in conjunction with the Senang Hati Foundation.

# *Social Program*

Some of our other projects are based on the needs of the community and have included food assistance and providing livestock to poor families, recovery relief programs (Bali Timor Refugees 1999, Bali Bomb 2002, Yogya Earthquake 2006), government school renovation projects, orphanage renovations and self-sustaining community projects.



## *Working Together*

Bali Hati opens its heart to working with any party that shares our mission. We have had successful alliances within and outside Bali: John Fawcett Foundation, Bali International Women's Association, Dental Faculty of Mahasaraswati University, East Bali Poverty Project, Senang Hati Foundation, YAKKUM, Rotary & Rotaract Clubs of Bali, America and Australia, Lions Australia, and the Balinese Children's Education Foundation in California, among others.

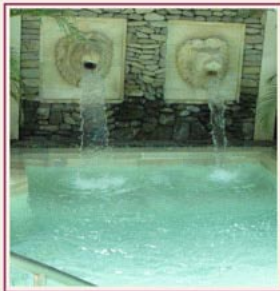
